

2019 Winter Travel League - Week # 3



The 2019 Winter Travel League season continued this morning at the Genesee Valley Conservation Club (GVCC) as just 21 shooters took part due to the bitter cold winter temperatures and deep snow. The GVCC crew was on the job very early this morning to battle the deep snow, set up the trap field, make sure the trap machine was going to work at zero degrees Fahrenheit, etc. They work hard to put on these winter trap shoots for you. Good job as usual guys. The shoot went safely, but also very quickly as 15 squads were done in three hours.

Turning to the scores, junior shooter Owen Neudeck from Richburg took the top honors for those shooting 100 targets today with an 86 x 100, followed by another junior, Eldred, PA's Zain Harvey with an 83. Rushford's Lynn Pomeroy was next with a 78. Dan Lowe from Portville led those shooting 50 targets today with his 45 x 50. No perfect scores of 25-straight were posted today. Fillmore's Ben Myers broke the **green bird** while Donna Beil from Cuba won the 50/50 drawing winning just \$8. Lynn has your winnings.

Our league shoots at five different clubs Sunday mornings through the end of March. A 50-bird trophy shoot, steak dinner, and awards ceremony will be held at the Richburg Rod & Gun Club, (the league's host this year), on Sunday, March 24th. You must shoot the entire 500 targets to be eligible for the 50-bird trophy shoot. Shooters will be broken into three classes (A, B, & C) which are determined by their season-ending average over the 500 targets. Whether you complete the entire 500-bird league or not you'll still get a steak dinner for your 15 bucks. Extra guest steak dinners will again be just \$8 each, but you must let me know if you're interested. New and returning trap shooters can still join any time up to the beginning of the second round on February 10th in Portville to shoot in the league for \$15.
